WHAT FIREARMS ARE ALLOWED ON WHAT RANGES

1. Bullseye range.
 - a. Handguns firing non-magnum loads only
 - b. .22 Rimfire rifles (non-magnum).
 - c. NO SHOTGUNS.
 - d. NO SHOOTING AT STEEL TARGETS.
2. Multi-purpose (PPC) range.
 - a. Handguns firing non-magnum loads only. See exception in Range Rules #12 (testing and sighting-in on lanes 15-16 only).
 - b. .22 Rimfire rifles (non-magnum except testing and sighting-in on lanes 15-16 only).
 - c. Center-fire rifles normally used in >SASS= matches (lever action with very light loads, generally straight-walled pistol calibers).
 - d. NO SHOTGUNS
 - e. NO SHOOTING AT STEEL TARGETS. See exception in Range Rules #13 (.22 Rimfire caliber miniature metallic silhouettes on the proper stands).
3. Bowling pin range.

All rules-allowed firearms (see below).
4. Steel range.

All rules-allowed firearms (see below).
5. **NOT ALLOWED ON ANY RANGE.**
 - a. Full auto firing.
 - b. High-powered rifles.
 - c. Handguns firing high-powered rifle cartridges.
 - d. Rifles or carbines other than Acowboy® lever action firing very light loads, generally straight-walled pistol calibers.
 - e. Black powder rifles (black powder pistols are OK).
 - f. Modern type center-fire carbines, regardless of caliber. Including MP-5, Uzi, and similar firearms.
 - g. Shotguns firing shot larger than #7 1/2.
